Meeting Topics:

- **Renovations:** We have renovated **Studio A and the front hallway**. The layout is functionally equivalent to the old one, but makes some much needed improvements. We hope that it will open up the Studio A space for more functional use and encourage the production of quality Freeform radio. Plus, it's great for on-air dance parties. A few notes:
 - New Layout The DJ consul now faces Studio Dee, allowing DJs to observe On-Air concerts. It also allows DJs to see out the windows and minimizes traffic bleed into the mics. The keyboard has been moved atop the desk and the equipment rack moved below. There is now more desk space for laptop computers, etc.
 - Sound Trap We will now be using **both Studio A doors** on a regular basis.
 Please do not prop these as they are important to the sound isolation in the studio.
 - Future Plans We have moved all of the major vinyl storage in Studio A and the library to rest on leveled planks atop the subfloor. This means that **replacing the carpet in the future** will avoid the arduous task of moving all of the vinyl. Should we have money left over this year, we will be replacing the hallway and Studio B carpet next.
- **Graffiti Policy:** To help protect the new Studio A layout and maintain our space and equipment, we have a **new graffiti policy**. We are proud to be a Freeform radio station and do some great non-conformist radio, but we still need our DJs to treat the station and our equipment with the respect it deserves.
