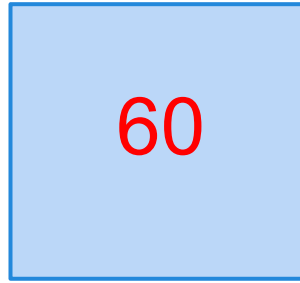

Scheduling Review

How scheduling works

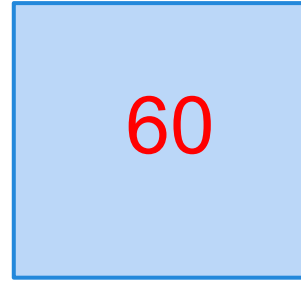
- You volunteer
- We put the number of hours into an equation
- The equation spits out a number (DJ Rank)
- We calculate your Show Rank
- We schedule shows starting from the highest Show Rank and work our way down

DJ Rank

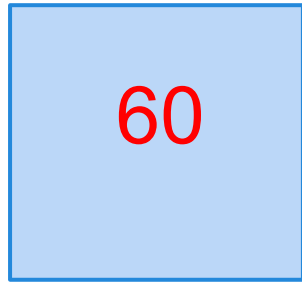

Show Rank

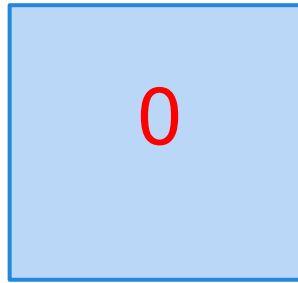
One DJ-show; DJ Rank = Show Rank

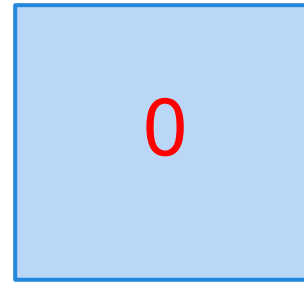

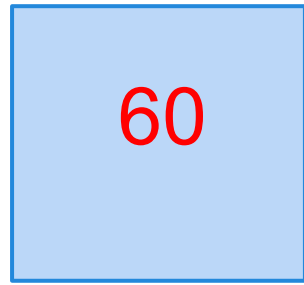

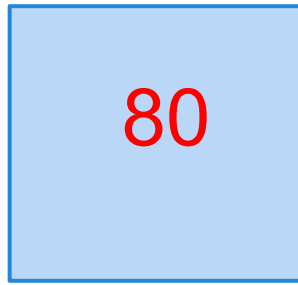
Two DJ-show; all DJs did NOT do at least five hours of volunteering; apply lowest DJ Rank

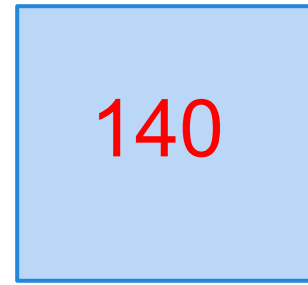

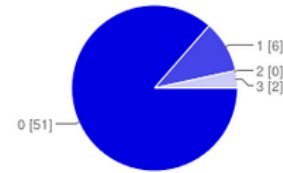
